

Vice President of Institutional Relations and Sustainable Development order which approves the adoption of extraordinary measures aimed at providing students of the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid with the resources necessary to continue with off-site teaching activities.

The situation caused by the Coronavirus Covid-19 pandemic has forced the suspension of all on-site teaching activity at the University, as approved by the President's Decision on the 14th March 2020.

As a result of this situation, academic activity is being developed in an off-site format, which requires minimal technology resources for students.

Being aware of the fact that, due to personal, familial or economic situations, some students may not have these minimum resources and are facing serious difficulties that prevent them from continuing with their off-site learning without incident, putting the continuation of their studies at risk, the necessary measures shall be implemented to provide these students with the necessary technological tools, within the limits of resources available.

Preference for the application of these measures will be given to applicants belonging to one of the following groups:

1. Being a recipient of a scholarship from the general call of the Spanish Ministry of Education for the 2019-20 academic year.
2. Having been a recipient of an Extraordinary Grant for students of the Universidad Carlos III de Madrid in situations arising in the 2018-19 or 2019-20 academic years.
3. Having been a recipient of a scholarship from the call for Enrolment Grants for students in adverse socio-economic situations in the 2018-19 academic year, resulting from the agreement between the Universidad Carlos III and the Community of Madrid.
4. Being a UC3M scholarship alumni.

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The applicants must responsibly declare that they are in one of the following situations:

1. They do not have access to technology that allows them to continue with off-site teaching.
2. They must share technology with other family members (they should indicate the number of people using it).

An electronic application form will be available for applicants in these situations to submit their application.

The application period will remain open for the entire period in which the suspension of on-site teaching, resulting from the President's Decision, is in effect.

The Commission that will decide on the granting of these measures of support will be formed of the Vice President of Institutional Relations and Sustainable Development, the Director, the Director of Support for Teaching and Degree Management and the Director of Student Counselling Services. The decision will be communicated via email to those who have submitted an application.

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
